The Vernon Parish Police Jury met in Regular Session, Monday, June 17, 2024 at 10 a.m. in the Police Jury meeting room with the following members **PRESENT**: James B. "Jim" Tuck – President, Marvin Hilton, Alton "David" Fox, Douglas "Doug" Roshong, Cody Hostetler, Scottie Benjamin, Charnel Bailey, Malcolm "Dean" Mitchell, Curtis Clay – Vice President, Steven "Quintin" Thompson, and Kenny Haymon. The following members were **ABSENT**: David Brister.

The Vernon Parish Police Jury was convened as the governing authority of the Parish of Vernon, by Mr. James B. "Jim" Tuck, President, and was then ready for the business on the agenda.

The invocation was given by Mr. Marvin Hilton and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Charnel Bailey.

Mr. Kim Johnson was present at the meeting to discuss new construction on Mary Hunt Road causing dirt to run across the road and into the ditches.

The President asked if there was any public comment on any agenda items; there was none.

A motion was made by Mr. Clay, seconded by Mr. Haymon and carried, to accept the minutes of the May 13, 2024 Committee meeting and the May 20, 2024 regular meeting and dispense with the reading of the minutes.

A motion was made by Mr. Hostetler, seconded by Mr. Hilton and carried, to adopt a resolution establishing a policy governing the requirements of Louisiana Revised Statute 42:14(E) to allow for any member of the public with disabilities recognized by the Americans with Disabilities Act or their designated care giver to participate in the meetings of the Vernon Parish Police Jury remotely by teleconferencing and providing for all other matters thereto.
